

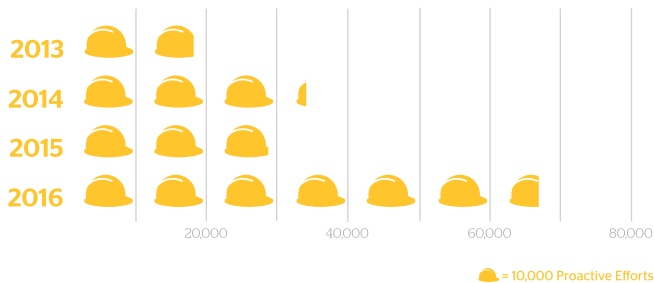

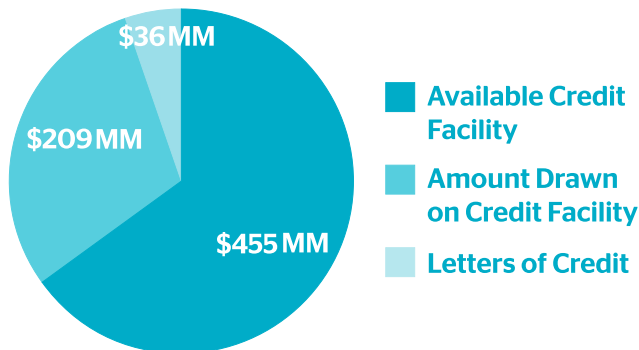

PROACTIVE SAFETY EFFORTS



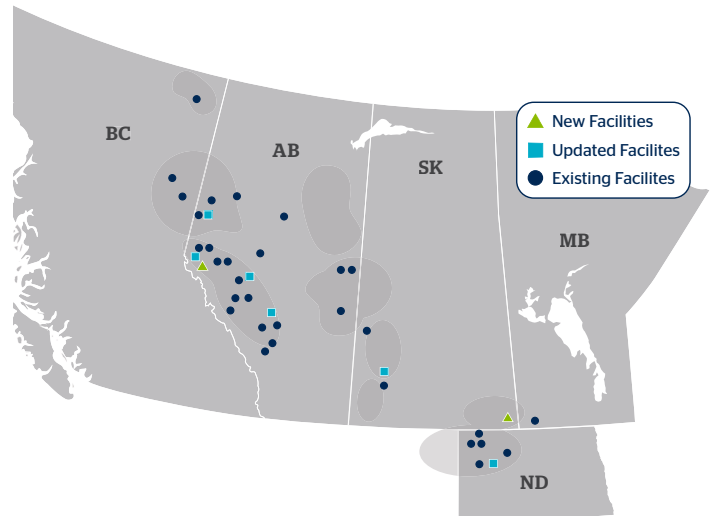
SECURE's safety culture is built around proactive reporting. Since 2013, there has been an increase in safety meetings, orientations, near misses and hazard identifications.

TOTAL CREDIT FACILITY

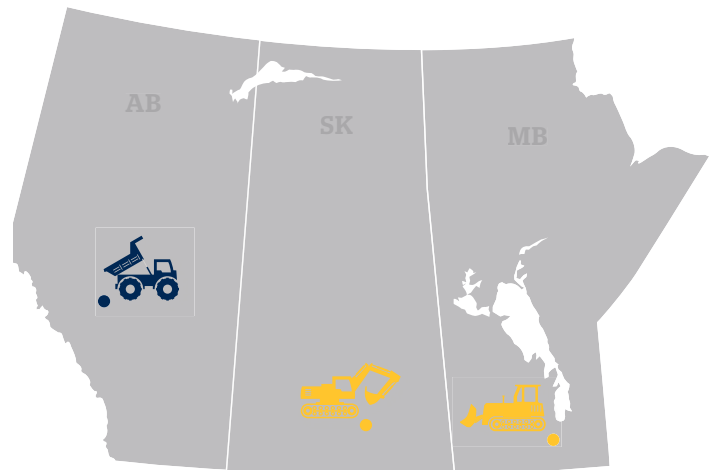


SECURE reduced the amount drawn on credit facility by 20 per cent, year-over-year to \$209 million in 2016. A total of \$700 million is available to make investments and grow the business where and when necessary.

INCREASING GEOGRAPHIC FOOTPRINT



SECURE opened a Full Service Terminal in the Kakwa region and acquired an oil blending terminal near Alida, SK bringing the total to 39. Six existing facilities have also been expanded throughout Canada and the United States.



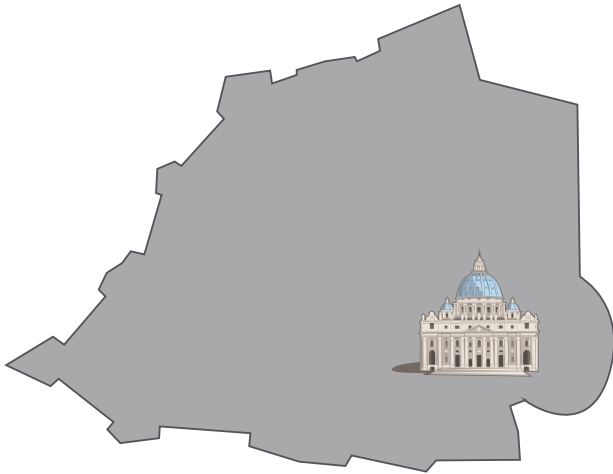
SECURE is at the forefront of environmental leadership by being the first to safely dispose of Naturally Occurring Radioactive Materials (NORM) in Alberta at the Pembina Landfill. Also, SECURE is now providing environmental services outside of the oil and gas industry in Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

CHARITABLE GIVING



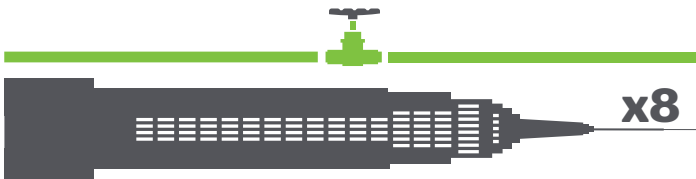
SECURE values long-term relationships with charitable organizations and provides employees time to contribute to causes they feel passionately about. At a corporate level, a combined total of \$620,000 was raised and donated.

ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP



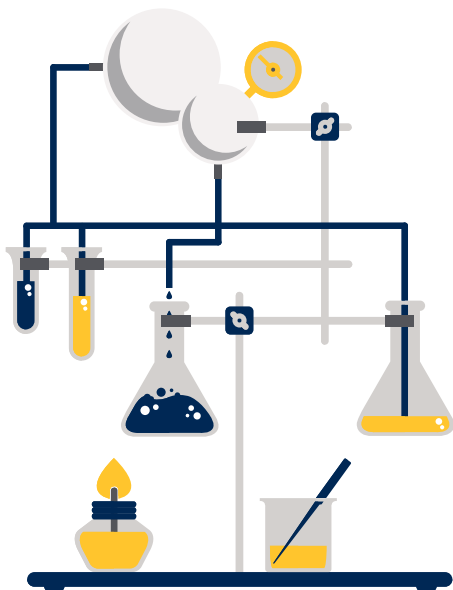
SECURE has completed hundreds of environmental site surveys and reclaimed over 100 acres of land - that is equal to the size of Vatican City in Rome.

PIPELINE INTEGRITY LEADERSHIP



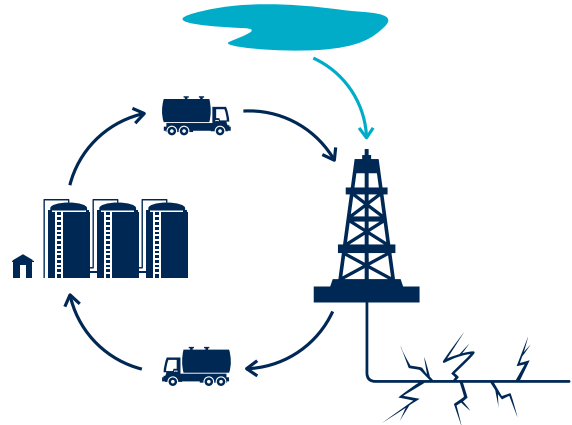
SECURE has completed over 100 pipeline integrity digs and inspected over 3,000 metres of pipeline for customers. That is the equivalent of the Empire State Building being laid on its side eight times end-to-end.

TECHNOLOGY



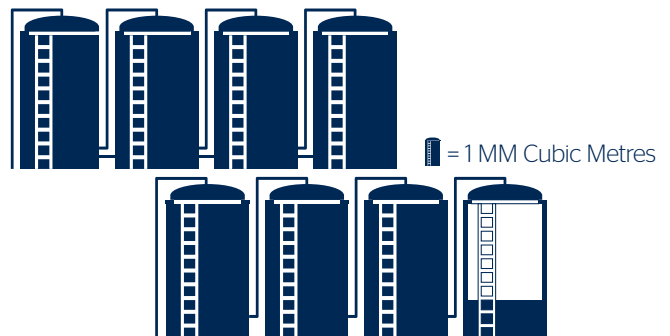
SECURE developed 125 new production chemicals for customers. These products are also used at SECURE's facilities for a total savings of \$528,800 that is passed on to customers.

COLLABORATION



SECURE participated in two studies on the water cycle of hydraulic fracturing and reducing the amount of freshwater used in these operations through partnerships with the BC Oil and Gas Commission, UBC Okanagan, Mitacs; and with the Alberta Energy Regulator and Alberta Environment and Parks.

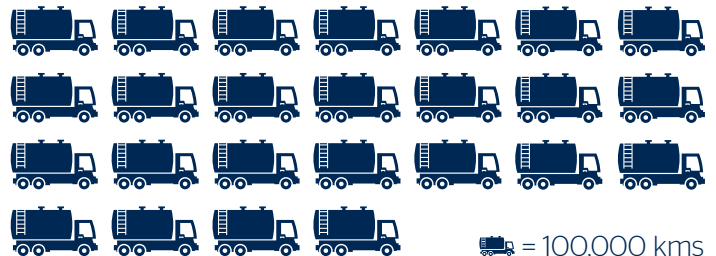
SAFELY MANAGING OILFIELD WASTE



SECURE has safely handled and disposed of approximately 7.3 million cubic metres of oilfield fluids across Canada and USA.



1.3 million tonnes of oilfield solids have been safely disposed of by SECURE through our network of disposal facilities and landfills.



SECURE's integrated fluid solutions helped customers avoid 2,500,000 kilometres of water hauling by truck.
